## **European Blitz Championship Open 2017 Regulation**

### 1. Place and terms

The 12th European Blitz Championship & 10th European Blitz Championship Women will take place in February, 26 in Palais des Festivals, Cannes, France. Playing Room: Salon des Ambassadeurs.

Preliminary schedule:

#### • February, 26

At 9.30 – Checking players list. Opening ceremony  
10.00-12.30 – Open Blitz tournament (Swiss-system, 9 rounds)  
14.00 – elimination part

### 2. General rules

Two separate championships (open and women) will be played.

NB! Depending on women players number, the chief referee and organisers may decide about playing on one group.

In any cases, didn't mention in these regulations – FMJD rules decide (Annex VI has the advantage).

### 3. System of competitions

Championship will be played in two parts:

1. Open Blitz Swiss tournament to get the 16 or 8 best players.

Tie-breaking by FMJD Annex 3 5.11.1.2. Only in case of all criteria of challengers for elimination part will be an equal, barrage should be played (2 games with the time control 5' + 3" per move (Fisher system) and if successor will not specified, then – games with time control 3' + 2" per move till the first winning).

2. Elimination part: (1/8,) 1/4, 1/2 and final.

Only in case of draw, tie-break games should be played (2 games with the time control 5' + 3" per move (Fisher system) and if champion will not specified, then – games with time control 3' + 2" per move till the first winning).

The exact elimination system will be decided by chief-referee depending on number of players and announced on opening.

### 4. Time control

Championship will be played with the time control 5' + 3" per move (Fisher system).

### 5. Rights of the players and referee

All rules concerning blitz games and rights – duties of players/referees described in FMJD annexes are valid.

6. Chief referee is Milena Szatkowska.

7. Participation fee: 40€ or 20€ (youth aged up to 19).

The players of European federations (men and women) finishing in the first three places will receive official medals and diplomas of European Championship.
